Adult Amateur Hunters

Open to horses and ponies ridden by an amateur. To show over a course of hunter type fences 2'9" to 3'0" in height. At the discretion of the horse show management, an Adult Amateur Hunter class may be combined with a Children's Hunter class if there are fewer than six (6) adult entries.

Children's Hunters

Open to horses and ponies ridden by a junior. To show over a course of hunter type fences 2'9" to 3'0" in height. At the discretion of the horse show management, a Children's Hunter class may be combined with an Adult Amateur Hunter class if there are fewer than six (6) adult entries.

Low Children's Hunters

Open to horses and ponies ridden by a junior 17&U rider, over a course of hunter type fences 2'6 in height. At the discretion of the horse show management, a Low Children's Hunter class may be combined with a Low Adult Amateur Hunter class if there are fewer than six (6) children's entries..

Low Adult Amateur Hunters

Open to horses and ponies ridden by an adult amateur 18 & Over rider, over a course of hunter type fences 2'6 in height. At the discretion of the horse show management, a Low Adult Amateur Hunter class may be combined with a Low Children's Hunter class if there are fewer than six (6) adult entries.

Equitation

Equitation classes are open only to junior and amateur riders.

Junior Equitation 12 & Under 2'6

Jr. Equitation 17 & Under 2'9

Amateur Equitation 18 & Over 2'9

Low Open Hunters

Open to horses or ponies. To be shown over a course of hunter type fences 2'6" in height.

Modified/Performance Hunters

This is an open division with horse or ponies to show over a course of hunter type fences 2'9" to 3'0" in height. Horse and rider may cross enter into any other division for which they are eligible.

Pleasure - Junior Pleasure/Senior Pleasure

Open to horses and ponies. Classes to count may include: Junior; Senior (rider age); Color; Non-Color; Bridle Path Hack; Open; Horse; and Pony.

Pony Hunter

Open to ponies (14.2 hands and under) ridden by a junior, over a course of hunter type fences 2'0" in height.

Short Stirrup – 11 & Under

Open to riders 11 and under who have never shown over fences 3'0" or higher. To be shown over a course of fences 2'0" in height.

Long Stirrup – 12 & Over

Open to amateur riders 12 & over who have never shown over fences 3'0" or higher. To be shown over a course of fences 2'0" in height.

Mini Stirrup - Child/Adult

Open to children and adult amateur riders who have never shown over fences 2'0" or higher. To be shown over a cross rail course of fences 18" in height. Trotting is allowed.

DIVISION SPECIFICATIONS CONTIUED

Walk-Trot 8 & Under

Open to riders 8 & under who have never shown in a class requiring the canter, prior to the current horse show year.

Future Jumpers .60-.65m

The Future Jumper division will show over a jumper type course with fences ranging from 1'11-2'1.

Emerging Jumper .70m-.75m

The Emerging division will show over a jumper type course with fences ranging from 2'3" to 2'7" in height.

Kindergarten Jumper .80m-.85m

The Kindergarten division will show over a jumper type course with fences ranging from 2'7" to 2'9" in height.

Low Child/Adult Jumper .90m-.95m

Open to horses and ponies ridden by a junior or adult amateur over a course of fences 3'-3'1".

Training Jumpers 1.00m

Horses and ponies are to show over a jumper type course with fences ranging from 3'3" with widths not to exceed 3'6".

SAHJA Pony Medal

Hunt Seat medal open to junior riders showing ponies (14.2 hands and under). The SAHJA Pony Medal shall be judged over a course of fences 2'3" in height, with two USEF tests (1-9) incorporated into the course. Jumper type equipment is not allowed. Any additional work off shall be at the judge's discretion.

SAHJA Mini Medal

Hunt Seat medal open to any junior or adult amateur rider who has not won a 3'6" USEF-rated medal class or any medal finals, except the SAHJA Pony Medal. Riders will be judged over a course of fences 2'6" in height, with at least two USEF tests (1-9) incorporated into the course. Jumper type equipment is not allowed. No work-offs are allowed.

SAHJA Child/Adult Medal

Hunt Seat medal open to any junior or adult amateur rider who has not won a 3'6" USEF-rated medal finals. Riders to be judged over a course of fences 3'0" in height. Jumper type equipment is not allowed. At least the top four riders will return for a flat work-off

RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.
- MANAGEMENT: The Horse Show Management reserves the right to itself to interpret all questions and conditions in regards to, or arising out of, or incident to the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in these Rules and Regulations shall be decided by the Horse Show Management; its decision to be final.
- 3. RESPONSIBILITY: The Horse Show Management reserves to itself the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any Riders or Competitors, prohibit exhibition of entries, and cancel award prizes, without claim for damages; to change any course, to add a dotted line, to cancel or combine any unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes, after due notice to Competitors; to change rings or rotate judges; to change specifications in Jumper classes as competition warrants and in compliance with all Federation rules.
- 4. STALLS: Trainers will be responsible for payment of all horse & tack stalls requested after entries due date has passed. An open check or credit card authorization form is required to hold stalls. The Show Office handles all stall transactions and charges. Private transactions involving stalls are not permitted. Request for stalls for horses not entered in the show or for tack, feed or grooming may be reduced by management and refunds given. NO STRAW ALLOWED. Wood or Canvas construction: Top & bottom doors size stalls are 10 x 10, 10 X 12, 12 X 12 most with rubber matts. Anyone dismantling stalls or causing damage to a stall(s) will be charged a \$100 fee per panel, with a maximum fine of \$400 per stall.

Curfew and quiet times must be observed between 9pm and 5am (as required by GR1215.3 #033-22)

- 5. ENTRY PROCEDURES: Entry blanks must be filled out completely, including all classes entered, COVID-19 and EHV materials (if required see www.murietaautumnclassic.com for Information), signatures and organizational membership numbers. Entry blanks must be postmarked on or before Tuesday, September 17, 2024 to receive Early Stall discount. After Tuesday, September 24, 2024, Post Entries are accepted. For each horse entered, a check or credit card for a deposit of \$200 must be included. All horses on the grounds must have a number, even non-showing horses. Numbers will not be issued without a check or credit card covering the balance of the entries.
 - Credit cards (Visa, Master Card, Discover and American Express): Card holder will be charged an additional
 3.5% over the published rates as the rates shown in the Prize List are discounted for paying by cash, check or
 money order. If paying by credit card, upon receipt of the entry blank, and/or credit card authorization form,
 Horse Show Management will charge the credit card for the Competition registration fees. Credit cards shall
 be presented to Horse Show Management in the office before or at the time of close out. If such card is not
 presented or an alternative method of payment is not made, Rider/Trainer/Owner agrees that Horse Show
 Management is authorized to charge the credit card pursuant to the information contained in the entry blank
 at the conclusion of the Competition.
 - Cash, Check or Money Order Payments: The rates in this Prize List reflect the 3.5% discount if paying by cash, check or money order. If paying by check, cash, or money order please submit the required payment, made payable to FoxFarms, Inc., with a complete entry blank for each showing or non-showing entry, on or by the published Entries Due.
- REGISTRATION FEE & ADD/SCRATCH POLICY: Registration Fee allows unlimited Adds/Scratches. Same day Adds/Scratchesvmust be done on an Add/Scratch Form or Trainer Form in the Horse Show Office. Horses scratching the show after the entries due will pay a scratch fee of \$200.
- OPEN ARENA FEE: Allows Competitors to ride Thursday and as arenas are available before the show. See Rule 35 for arena lights. Jumper rings close 1 hour before start, and hunters 30 to 45 minutes before start.
- 8. HORSE SUBSTITUTION POLICY: After Entries Due substituting a scratched horse with another horse within the same Trainer's barn is allowed, the substituted horse will pay a substitution fee of \$35 in addition to all other fees. The scratched horse will pay a scratch fee of \$200. No substituting allowed after a horse has shown. ALL SUBSTITUTION MUST BE DONE BEFORE THE START OF THE SHOW.
- 9.**REFUND POLICY:** All refund requests must be submitted in writing.
 - A. Before entries due, Tuesday, September 24, 2024, all paid fees will be credited or refunded.
 - B. After entries due, the show and RV deposit will not be refunded.
 - C. No request for refunds will be accepted after the close of the show.

- 9. RETURNED CHECKS: Checks returned by the bank for any reason are regarded as a most serious offense and will be handled in the following procedure. 10% OF THE AMOUNT OF THE CHECK WILL BE ASSESSED FOR EACH RETURNED CHECK OR MINIMUM OF \$50. Accounts will be given ten days to be paid in full with cash, or cash equivalent or they will be turned into USEF and PCHA for further disciplinary action.
- CREDIT CARD CHARGEBACK: Chargebacks for any reason are regarded as a most serious offense. Please contact (916) 305-8898 for questions.
- 11. **UNPAID CHARGES:** If the Show Management or Show Official (i.e. farrier, veterinarian, feed supplier, photographer, food concessionaire, etc.) must bill a Competitor/Owner for unpaid charges, a \$50 billing fee will be added to the amount due.
 - A. Past unpaid balances Competitor/Owner will be notified of any previous balance at the time of check-in. Outstanding balances must be paid prior to picking up show numbers. Horse Show Management reserves the right to require a deposit paid to cover all show expenses and any portion of the deposit that is unused will be mailed to the addressee on file no later than 15 days after the close of the show.
 - B. **Unpaid Balances** Competitor/Owner who do not come into the office to close out by 5pm at the end of the show forfeit the right to adjustments on any show charges. Final balances will be automatically charged to the payment method on file.
- 12. **PRIZE MONEY**: <u>Prize money will not be deducted from the show bill</u>, prize money will be made payable to the Payee or Owner listed if indicated on the Entry blank and mailed within 30 days after the show.
 - PRIZE MONEY WILL NOT BE MAILED UNLESS THE OWNER OR PAYEE'S SOCIAL SECURITY/TAX ID NUMBER IS
 LISTED ON THE ENTRY BLANK. REQUESTS MADE WITHIN 60 DAYS AFTER THE SHOW WILL INCUR A \$100 FEE TO BE
 DEDUCTED FROM THE PRIZE MONEY. ALL CHECK REQUESTED 60 DAYS AFTER THE SHOW WILL RECEIVE A CREDIT
 FOR A FUTURE SHOW. CHECKS NOT CASHED WITHIN 90 DAYS AFTER THE SHOW WILL FORFEIT ALL PRIZE MONEY.
 - ANY RETURNED PRIZE MONEY CHECKS DUE TO INCORRECT ADDRESS ON ENTRY BLANK A \$125 WILL BE DEDUCTED FROM THE PRIZE MONEY.
 - REQUESTING 1099 CHANGES AFTER THEY HAVE BEEN MAILED WILL BE CHARGED \$125 TO BE PAID IN ADVANCE. PRIZE MONEY WON BY FOREIGN COMPETITORS: Foreign competitors are advised that the U.S. Internal Revenue Service requires sporting events to with hold 30% of prize money won in the United States. Foreign competitors should apply for a U.S. Social Security number and will be asked to complete form W-8BEN prior to issuing prize money won.
- 13. ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE: Horses arriving and/or departing before and/or after these dates & times will be billed \$50 per day per horse.

Arrive no earlier than Monday, 12pm October 14, 2024, Depart by 7pm Sunday, October 20, 2024.

- 14. PARKING: Horse trailers will be parked in designated areas. Autos will also be parked in designated areas. There will be no autos allowed in the barn area and aisles.
- 15. **RV's:** Weekend (arriving Thursday Sunday) rate of \$250 30amp & \$325 50amp please book your RV space by emailing theclassicshowslive@gmail.com. if cancelled before the entries due date a credit will be provided for current or future show. The RV deposit of \$125 is non-refundable after entries due date.
 - RV'S ARRIVING WITHOUT A RESERVATION WILL PAY AN ADDITIONAL \$100 OVER THE RATE, AS SPACE ALLOWS. RV'S arriving and/or departing before and/or after the scheduled dates & times will be billed a minimum of \$50 per day. See Rule 13.
- 22. **FEED AND BEDDING:** All orders must be made through the Horse Show Office (916) 305-8898.
- 23. **MEDICAL WASTE:** Needles must be placed in the proper receptacles. Anyone found in violation shall be subject to a fine or other penalties deemed necessary by Show Management.
- 24. **NUMBERS:** Management will provide a number card for each Horse. Horses are now required to have a back number attached to their neck or their rider when outside of their barn/portable stall (as per HJ106.2 #247-22). Riders wearing the wrong number or no number at all may be eliminated from the class by the judge.
- 25.TRAINER SPLITS: This service allows Trainers to split the show charges for miscellaneous items to their clients. Splits will be accepted until 5pm Saturday any splits after Saturday will subject to a \$5 office charge per entry. Only items billed by the horse show will be split. Splits will revert back to the trainer for payment if uncollected. FEED & BEDDING ORDERS AFTER 5pm FRIDAY WILL NOT BE INCLUDED IN THE SPLIT AND WILL BE BILLED TO THE TRAINER.

- 26. **POLING:** Not allowed in California.
- 27. HARD HATS: It is compulsory for all persons at hunter/jumper competitions when mounted anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/ SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly \fitted with harness secured. Exception: In Hunter or Jumper classes, adults may be a allowed to remove their headgear while accepting prizes and during the playing of the National Anthem only; they must refasten their headgear prior to the lap of honor. It is compulsory for riders in Paso Fino classes, both open and breed restricted including Hunter Hack, where jumping is required and when jumping anywhere on the competition grounds to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. A Show Committee must bar riders without protective headgear from entering the ring for classes in which protective headgear is required and may bar any entry or person from entering the ring if not suitably presented to appear before an audience.
- 28. MOTORIZED VEHICLES: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/ legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or quardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
- 29.DOGS: Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be held on a leash or otherwise restrained. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses, or actions resulting from their dogs' behaviors. Dog owners failing to comply with this rule will be issued a Yellow warning card and may be subject to penalty under Chapter 7. Management reserves the right to call Animal Control to have an animal removed from the premises.
- 30.**SCHOOLING SUPERVISION:** Please be advised that paddock stewards are schooling supervisors and have absolute authority to scratch riders who do not follow USEF schooling rules. They can scratch riders without going through the USEF Steward or the Horse Show Manager.
- 31.TIME SCHEDULE/POSTED ORDER: Each day by 7pm the next day's time schedule will be available on www.horseshowing.com. This time schedule and/or posted orders will be strictly adhered to. The Trainer, Competitor or other representative must tell the paddock steward of possible ring conflicts so that arrangements can be made to accommodate the rider as well as the time schedule. All management decisions will be final.
- 32. ARENAS: All show and warm-up arenas consist of GGT footing.
- 33. HAUL INS: A \$50 haul-in fee per horse per day will be allowed if the entry is received on or before "Entry Due Date" with a payment on file. After Entry Due Date only stalls will be available. Horses coming from VS Affected Counties will not be able to haul-in and will require a stall. Horses coming from an affected County will be required to meet VS Show Protocols which can be found at: www.murietaautumnclassic.com
- 34.NON SHOWING POLICY: For any horse on the grounds not officially entered, owner or trainer of said horse must complete a entry blank and write in the in the area of the Entry Blank used for classes "Non-Showing" and sign the entry blank at the Horse Show Office, pay a \$150 Non Showing Fee, EMT Fee, and a Stall Fee.
- 35. **ARENA LIGHTS:** Lights will be on in the GGT Arena Wednesday through Sunday 6am 7am.
- 36. **HUNTER CLASSICS:** Hunter Classics are two rounds. The last class of the division is the first round of the Hunter Classic.

- 37. COVID-19: All Competitors, Trainers, Staff and additional personal are required to adhere to ALL USEF, Murieta Equestrian Center, FoxFarms Inc. and Sacramento County, requirements and guidelines as they relate to COVID-19 and or the protection of everyone on the showgrounds. All waivers and forms must be completed before entering the show grounds. forms can be accessed at www.northernwinterclassics.com.
- 38. **EQUINE VACCINATION RULE GR845:** At Federation licensed competitions horses, more than 7 months of age, entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. See USEF.org for outline of documentation required.
- 39. Equine Herpes Virus (EHV) & Vesicular Stomatitis (VS): All Competitors, Trainers, Owners, Staff and additional Personal are required to adhere to ALL USEF, Murieta Equestrian Center, FoxFarms Inc. and California State requirements and guidelines as they relate to EHV, VS and or the protection of everyone on the showgrounds. All waivers and forms must be completed before entering the show grounds, forms can be accessed at www.murietaautumnclassic.com. Management may impose a Biosecurity fee.

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
